Want a Private Lesson

The Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club is offering the opportunity for our Basic Skills “Learn to Skate” skaters to take private lessons. These lessons are offered to give the student “one on one” instruction to improve their skills, work towards a competition or ice show number, advance more quickly through the levels, or work on long term goals.

A Professional Staff member or a Junior Coach may be contacted for private lessons.

How it Works!

1. Come to the office and inform the staff of your interest in private lessons
2. Ask for the spring ice time schedule and private lesson request form.
3. You may have one lesson a week on any general ice session, so decide what time and day of the week would work best for you
4. Complete the private lesson request form
5. Designate whether your interest is long or short term and if you have any coach preferences.
6. Return the completed form to the office staff
7. Lesson times are arranged directly through the instructor so make sure this is discussed in advance
8. Ice time **MUST** be scheduled and paid for in the AAFSC office **BEFORE** starting lessons.

SHOOTING STARS

The shooting Stars Program is designed to progress the Basic 6 and above skater in a faster pace program. Skaters will rotate between different stations and instructors to work on the more advanced skating skills. This includes, but is not limited to, spins, jumps, edges, dance and artistry. Skaters working on Basic 6 and above are invited to join this program and skaters who have passed Basic 8 are automatically promoted to the Shooting Stars Program.

The **Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club** is committed to a Basic Skills “Learn to Skate” program of excellence. Our classes follow the guidelines developed by United States Figure Skating (USFS) and are divided according to age and ability. To insure the best quality, all of our instructors are experienced in the test and competitive structure and are present members of the USFS. Priority is placed on giving individual attention within the group environment so that the skater can feel comfortable and progress to their maximum potential. If you should have any questions regarding our instructors or the coordinator of our Learn to Skate Program, please contact the Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club office.

AAFSC Refund and Credit Policy

There will be no refunds issued for Learn to Skate classes. If a skater drops the class within 14 days of the start of the regular scheduled session, a credit will be issued to the skater’s account. After 14 days, a class can be dropped only for medical reasons with a Doctor’s note. All credits will be prorated from the date the class is dropped. Please see the office staff if you wish to drop a Learn to Skate class. They may be reached during normal business hours.

Skates, Helmets and Clothing

Rental skates and helmets are available for all classes at no extra charge. Helmets are strongly recommended for skaters under 5 years of age and all beginning skaters. Helmets are limited in number and are available on a first come basis. You may bring your own bicycle or hockey helmet. Skaters should wear gloves and warm comfortable clothing.

Beginning Hockey

The class is play oriented covering introduction skating and basic hockey skills for ages 3 – 6.

The student will be earning hockey badges 1 – 4 which will consist of proper stance, marching across the ice, swizzles, snowplow stops, backward skating, crossovers, mohawks and much more.

Hockey skills will consist of carrying, shooting, and passing the puck.

You must be an Ann Arbor Figure Skating Club Basic Skills' member to participate.

Equipment recommended for beginner hockey class:

- * Hockey helmet with a mask
- * Hockey stick
- * Elbow pads
- * Knee pads

We also encourage you to enroll your child in our Learn to Skate program to help develop skating skills more rapidly.
